



-BECOME A TUTOR

Tutors represent a fundamental part of the project and are an integral component of the organizational staff. They serve as reference points for participating teachers and students, Italian and international school groups, guests, speakers, artists, and collaborators. Their contribution makes the success of the Festival's educational and cultural experience possible.

Tutor's needed skills:

- a collaborative spirit and the ability to work in a team;
- dynamism, flexibility, and a strong sense of responsibility;
- openness to interacting with people from different cultures;
- curiosity, enthusiasm, and a willingness to get involved;
- strong interpersonal and communication skills.

The staff works in an international, informal yet highly professional environment, where group spirit and sharing are central elements of the experience.

-THE ROLE OF THE TUTOR

Tutors will mainly act as tour leaders and group escorts, becoming daily points of reference for participants. They will play a conscious and responsible organizational support role, always in coordination with the teachers and the EFAE team.

Main activities include:

- welcoming and assisting groups and teachers;
- accompanying participants during transfers and daily activities;
- providing information about the program and managing activity schedules;
- offering organizational support to other staff members (hostesses, stewards, workshop facilitators, actors, trainers, etc.);
- collaborating during workshops, evening activities, and cultural events.

More specifically:

- you will travel with the school group assigned to you;
- you will maintain direct contact with the reference teachers;
- you will check attendance and group movements;
- you will help ensure that the program schedule is respected;
- you will accompany and actively take part in the planned activities.

Courtesy, availability and empathy - even during challenging moments - are essential to offer everyone an unforgettable experience.

Tutors are required to maintain respectful and cooperative behavior, represent the association with professionalism, protect the well-being of participants, and promote a calm, inclusive, and participatory environment.
